



BOARDING AGREEMENT

Here at Bark & Play, we want your dog to feel like they are at their home away from home. Here you will find the answers to any questions that you may have concerning their stay with us.

RESERVATIONS- Reservations are required for an overnight or extended stay. Daycare for the day they come to stay with us and the day they go home is already included. An advanced reservation during the holidays is highly recommended. Give us a call or send us an E-mail to reserve your dog a spot. We have numerous kennels and crates to accommodate all who show up for the slumber party!

DROP OFF- Dogs that are spending the night with us may be dropped off at any time during our hours of operation. We encourage them to show up to the party by 6pm so they have some time to run around and catch up on their gossip before quiet time. Please allow a few extra minutes when you drop your dog off to give us feeding instructions and answer any questions we may have.

PICK UP- You can pick up your dog any time during our hours of operation. If they are picked up after 7pm, an additional charge of \$10 will be added. Please allow a few extra minutes at pick up time so the humans can make sure that all of your dogs belongings are not being left behind.

WHAT TO BRING- We want your dog to be as comfortable with us as they are at home. Feel free to bring their beds, a few toys, any medication that they are on and food. Please bring their food in a plastic container with a lid and your dogs name on it. Plastic grocery bags, paper bags, and non resealable food bags will not be accepted. Their beds should also have their names on them so they don't try to share with their friends and get them mixed up! If you would rather leave their bed at home, we have beds and blankets that will be provided. Medication must be in its original container with instructions clearly visible. We encourage a few toys that your dog can enjoy while they are in their rooms away from their friends.

WHAT NOT TO BRING- We provide bowls for food and for water while your dog is staying with us. Please leave your dogs bowls at home. Raw Hide bones may be tasty and help calm your dog, but they are also a major choking hazard and should only be enjoyed under close supervision. We are staffed 24 hours a day, but we request you bring a Nyla bone instead.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES- For an additional cost, we offer baths, nail trims and brush outs before you take your dog home. Please let us know when you drop your dog off if these services are required to ensure your dog is ready on time.

BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION- Bark & Play uses non-violent methods of behavior intervention such as using a squirt bottles filled with water, hoses, shouting, loud noises, employees stomping their feet or nap time in a crate or kennel.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION- Even though Bark & Play requires that all dogs be up to date with their Bordetella (Kennel Cough) vaccinations, it does not always protect against new strains of the virus. Dogs that are exposed to day care and boarding environments may contract it even with the vaccination. To help protect better against this, a 6 month vaccination is recommended. **Bark & Play assumes no responsibility for vet bills.**

It is not unusual for your dog to experience signs of fatigue that include sleeping, loss of appetite and some general lethargy when they come home. After a few days of rest, they should be back to normal. If

symptoms persist, please call Bark & Play as soon as possible to let us know.

If at any time you are unable to pick up your dog after a boarding stay or day care, it required that staff at Bark & Play be notified of who will be picking up your pup. Please let whoever comes to pick up your dog that a picture ID will be required before they are released into their care.
